

Admission Guidelines for Residential LAW Colleges

(i) Telangana Tribal Welfare Residential Law College for Man, Sangareddy.

1. A cut off in age criteria, that is, the candidate shall not cross the age of 21 years as on 01.10.2023.
2. The candidate must maintain an attendance of atleast 75% as laid down by Osmania University.
3. The candidate must not be married as such admissions are not feasible in residential pattern of the college.
4. The candidates who have already completed their graduation are not eligible to apply/opt our institution.
5. The candidate has to abide by the rules and regulations put forth by TTWREIS Gurukulam, Hyderabad.

8. If a candidate seeks admissions in the batches of 2020-25, 2021-26 & 2022-27, he must fit into the vacancy as per the approved seat matrix. He must submit an undertaking to abide by the rules and regulations of residential pattern in the college.
