You are aware that the Final phase of TSLAWCET/TSPGLCET-2018 web based counseling/allotment of seats has been completed by 19th November, 2018 for the academic year 2018-2019. You are therefore requested to furnish the complete details of vacancy position of your institution through online website i.e., lawcetadm.tsche.ac.in and also Email to convenertslawcet@gmail.com latest by

20th November. 2018.

The vacant seats if any may be filled by candidates as per their merit in TSLAWCET / TSPGLCET-2018 through SPOT ADMISSIONS at your institution level on the scheduled date. You are requested to give a notification in one of the leading daily News Papers of your region (an original copy to be submitted) calling the candidates, who possess the essential qualifications and who have qualified in TSLAWCET/TSPGLCET-2018 examination to attend for spot admission at your institution **on scheduled date** for Spot admissions for the left over vacancies/ dropout vacancies/ cancelled seats if any at the institutional level. The candidates should be advised to produce all the original certificates before admission and one set of Photo copies should be submitted at the time of ratification with the Principal's signature. All spot admissions shall be filled strictly in accordance with the regulations prescribed in G.O.Ms.No.64. dt.26.05.2006 /GO.Ms.No.250. dt.27.10.2008, GO.Ms.No.31.dt.18.03.2009 and GO.Ms.No.116. dt.07.08.2007 (As per GO.Ms. No. 64 para no 6 (ii) 12 the vacant seats handed over by the Convener shall be notified and filled by the institution on merit basis following the Rules of Reservation as provided under Rule 7. Such seats in case of unaided Minority Institutions shall be first filled with eligible candidates belonging to the concerned Minority and then with eligible candidates belonging to other than the concerned Minority.) as the case may be and their subsequent amendments. **Any deviation made in this regard will be viewed seriously and such admissions will not be ratified under any circumstance.** The cut-off date for Private Law College Managements to fill the left over vacancies is **28th November 2018.**

The seats earmarked for women candidates in OC/BC/SC/ST categories are to be offered first to women candidates only. If women candidates are not available in that category, then the seats are to be offered to male candidates. The women candidates are also eligible to opt for male seats (General seats) in the combined rank order in any category (OC/BC/SC/ST) even after their own 1/3 quota of seats are filled. If candidates (male/female) are not available in one reservation category, the seats are to be offered to the next reservation category as mentioned below.

Example: 1. BC-E (Girl) → BC-E (Boy) → BC-A (Girl) → BC-A (Boy) →
 BC-B (Girl) → BC-B (Boy) → BC-C (Girl) → BC-C (Boy) →
 BC-D (Girl) → BC-D (Boy) → OC (Girl) → OC (Boy)

In case, seats reserved for BC category are unfilled even after exhausting all the candidates of BC-A,B,C,D and E (following rules of conversion), such seats may be offered to OC Candidates.

The detailed notification for spot admissions should be kept in your college website also and the same should be mailed to the Convener, TSLAWCET/TSPGLCET-2018.

ELIGIBILITY FOR TSLAWCET / TSPGLCET ADMISSIONS 2018

- **3 - Year LL.B :** Candidates should have passed any Degree (10+2+3 pattern) of a recognized University with 45% of aggregate marks or any other examination recognized as equivalent by the Universities concerned. 44.5% or more shall be rounded off and treated as 45%.
- The candidates who have less than the prescribed percentage but have secured the same percentage or more on the aggregate in any PG Degree (Masters Degree) or B.Ed are eligible.
- The candidates should have qualified in the TSLAWCET-2018
- **Note: There is a relaxation of 5% of marks in the above qualifying examinations for 3 year Law course in favour of the Candidates belonging to SC / ST.**
- **The candidates who have passed Degree examination by single sitting without undergoing three years course either through regular or private or correspondence and those who obtained the degree through Open University directly without having any basic qualification are not eligible.**

- **5 - year LL.B** : Candidates should have passed 2 year Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) with 45% of aggregate marks or any other examination recognized as equivalent by the University concerned or the Board of Intermediate Education, T.S./A.P. 44.5% or more shall be rounded off and treated as 45%.
- The candidates should have qualified in the TSLAWCET-2018
- **Note: There is a relaxation of 5% of marks in the above qualifying examinations for 5 year Law course in favour of the Candidates belonging to SC / ST.**
- **LL.M:** The candidates should have passed LL.B / BL (3/5 year) from recognized University
- The candidates should have qualified in the TSPGLCET-2018

Processing Fee: Candidates have to pay a non-refundable processing fee of Rs.800/- and Rs.500/- in case of SC/ST at the time of certificate verification

Amount should be remitted in the form of single Demand Draft (Consolidated for all the candidates) drawn in favor of **CONVENER TSLAWCET PGLCET-2018 ADMISSIONS**, Payable at Hyderabad and submit the same to Convener TSLAWCET & PGLCET-2018
